

Motion to eliminate the executive position of “Volunteer Coordinator” and reallocate their duties to the position of “Academic Accessibility Representative”

WHEREAS in the past situations for which the Volunteer Coordinator would have taken responsibility did not occur

WHEREAS a new executive position (namely, that of “Editor-In-Chief”) is being created and the number of executives of SoPhiA is unnecessarily large

WHEREAS the duties of the “Academic Accessibility Representative” are similar to those of the “Volunteer Coordinator”

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the position of “Volunteer Coordinator” be removed from SoPhiA’s by-laws

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the duties of “Volunteer Coordinator” be added to those of the “Academic Accessibility Representative”

Current description of duties of “Volunteer Coordinator” (8h): “The Volunteer Coordinator: shall be responsible for acting as an executive of an additional operation deemed necessary by the executive committee. The responsibilities will be determinable by each incoming executive committee. The Volunteer Coordinator is also responsible for organizing and mobilizing students for events that have direct participation.”

Current description of duties of “Academic Accessibility Representative” (8f): The Academic Accessibility Representative: shall be the main representative of the Association on all matters relating to curriculum within the Department and shall also be responsible for coordinating all academic services and events provided for the Members.

Proposed changes to 8f: The Academic Accessibility Representative: shall be the main representative of the Association on all matters relating to curriculum within the Department and shall also be responsible for coordinating all academic services and events provided for the Members. The Academic Accessibility Representative shall also be responsible for acting as an executive of an additional operation deemed necessary by the executive committee. The responsibilities will be determinable by each incoming executive committee. They will also be responsible for organizing and mobilizing students for events that have direct participation.
